REDEEMER PRAYER GUIDE DAILY FOCUS



Mondays: Kingdom Come

Your Kingdom Come (Matthew 6:10) Our vision is to see God's kingdom fill the earth. Pray for increasing signs of the kingdom: God's presence, justice, healing, salvation and deliverance, peace, comfort and joy. Pray for "God's word multiplied" (Acts 12:24) and that our city and surrounding areas would be a place of increasing devotion to God and His word.

Health and Healing (Galatians 5:1) God came to set people free from captivity, bringing healing in physical, emotional and spiritual ways. Pray for healing, peace and comfort for those suffering, and for those in healing roles like doctors, nurses, therapists and leaders.

Signs and Wonders (John 14:12) Jesus said, "greater things than these will you do". Let's pray for an increase in signs and wonders; for those who need a miracle, and let's ask God to increase our faith as we seek to learn and share testimonies of His goodness.

Tuesdays: Church

Church, Groups and Ministries (Ephesians 3:10) Pray for the Church to display the manifold wisdom of God. For unity and God to strengthen people to keep doing good works (Eph 2:10) and for influence through relational networks, groups and ministries.

Love One Another (Matthew 22:39) The second greatest commandment is to "love your neighbour as yourself". Pray for healthy relationships between people. Seek God about whether there is anyone to forgive or seek reconciliation with. Pray for Christians to be known by their love for one another (John 13:35).

Worship and Encountering the Father (Matthew 22:37) Jesus' greatest commandment is to "love the Lord with all your heart, soul, mind and strength". Let's pray for an increasing sense of passion and commitment to worship and encounter the Father (Luke 15:11-32). Pray also for our musicians as they lead the way.

Wednesdays: Mission

Multiplying Disciples (Matthew 28:19) Jesus called us to "go and make disciples of all nations". Let's pray for salvation for the lost and strength on the journey for those who know Jesus. Consider using the Prayer Calendar (pg. 7) to pray for those God places on your heart.

Next Generation (Matthew 19:14) Jesus loves children! Pray for our children, young people and those in education. Choose a school or university and pray for the teachers and pupils who attend. It's true that it "takes a village to raise a child", who will you pray for?

Mission and the Nations (Revelation 7:9) Pray big prayers for every tribe and tongue to be represented in God's kingdom as promised in scripture. Choose a nation to pray for; we are called to be God's witnesses to the end of the earth (Acts 1:8).

Thursdays: Government & Business

Business and Government (Genesis 1:28) God created mankind to take dominion over this earth. He is interested in every area of society. Join us by praying for workplaces, our economy and local businesses. Pray for national and international governments; for peace, wisdom and integrity for those who lead.

Leaders & Lawmakers (1 Tim 2:1-4) God's common grace extends to all humanity. Pray that our leaders and those in authority would make decisions and govern wisely, compassionately and courageously. Pray for leaders of integrity so that our nation would flourish.

Unity and Common Good (Matthew 12:15) The general political climate throughout the nation is one of divided, tribal political parties. Pray that members of political parties would put their agendas aside to work together in humility to serve for the good of our nation.

Fridays: Pioneering situations

Chelmsford: Pray specifically for the Chelmsford Church Plant. That God would raise up and call leaders for that group, that hose already gathering would be marked by courage, unity and devotion. Pray for salvation from the first days and an 'adding' to the group of believers. Pray for favour with others in the city

Newfrontiers: Relational Mission came from a larger family of churches called <u>Newfrontiers</u> (now a group of apostolic leaders partnering together on global mission, joined by common values and beliefs, shared mission and genuine relationships.) Pray that these aspects would continue to grow stronger and more fruitful as we reach across the world.

Sundays: Sunday Gatherings

Pray our gatherings would be marked by encountering the Lord through His manifest presence, preaching, worship, spiritual gifts, and prayer. Pray that everyone would come to know the Lord in ever-increasing measure and affection. Pray for unity, forgiveness and missional zeal to mark us out.
