Helpful Tips

Jesus got up very early in the morning to spend time with His Heavenly Father. In order for prayer to work, we should do the same. Make a daily appointment with God and keep it.

A CERTAIN PLACE

Jesus had a prayer place. Your prayer place needs to be an undistracted environment where you can pray out loud and perhaps have some worship music playing in the background.

A CERTAIN PLAN

Go into your prayer time with a plan. If it changes that's fine. When Jesus taught His disciples how to pray, He gave His disciples a prayer outline. We call it the Lord's Prayer.


DAY 1 FOCUS // PRIVILEGE





DAY 2 FOCUS // ACCESS




DAY 3 FOCUS // PRESENCE





DAY 1 FOCUS // PURPOSE




DAY 2 FOCUS // OBEDIENCE

Prayer is not merely an invitation it is a command. Jesus does not merely suggest a way of life to us. He commands us to learn to really follow him. But his commands are not burdensome.




DAY 3 FOCUS // FASTING


Week Focus // Pupose & Power

DAY 4 FOCUS // POWER


DAY 5 FOCUS // THE HOLY SPIRIT




Week Focus // Petitioning & Pursuit


DAY 4 FOCUS // DEPENDENCY

Prayer is not so much an act as it is an attitude - an attitude of dependency, dependency upon God.




DAY 5 FOCUS // YEARNING
